About Time covers lots of different ways of thinking about time, including how animals and plants react to the passing of time. It also looks at the way in which time is divided into hours, days, weeks etc. and how units of time have been divided differently by different civilisations. There is a section on how to tell the time without using a clock e.g. using the phases of the moon or the position of the sun in the sky.
